Benefits and Conditions of Award

1. Advantages, benefits, and support offered to a Drama Scholar:

- I. Performance opportunities in School productions.
- II. Backstage and/or technical support opportunities during School productions.
- III. Mentoring of younger performers in the School.
- IV. Directing other students for House Drama.
- V. One-to-one acting tuition, leading towards LAMDA exams.
- VI. Theatre Trips, mainly in central London.

2. Obligations of the Drama Scholar:


- a. A Student who is the recipient of a Drama Scholarship is required to contribute fully to the dramatic life of the School by active participation in our co-curricular Drama programme and positive contribution to curricular Drama.
 - i. Drama Scholars will remain available for rehearsals throughout their time as a Drama Scholar.
 - ii. Drama Scholars will commit to participating in a range of School productions in either an acting or technical capacity.
 - iii. Drama Scholars will actively participate in our Lamda/RADA programme of performance examinations.
- b. Maintain high standards of attitude and motivation within performance, examinations and School life.
- c. Lead by example, acting as a role model for peers and as an ambassador for the School.

3. Obligations of the Parent/s:

- a. Parents are expected to support and encourage the Drama Scholar to achieve their obligations and to uphold the aims and the good name of the School.

4. Withdrawal of the Scholarship:

- a. The annual continuation of the Scholarship is subject to sporting, academic and behavioural performance and is at the discretion of the Headmaster.



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- b. If a Drama Scholar is unable to or is failing to meet his or her obligations, the School reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship with a full half term's notice.
- c. A Drama Scholar who wishes to withdraw himself or herself from the Scholarship programme must provide the Headmaster with a full half term's notice, in writing. Parental consent is also required in this instance.
- d. All 11+ scholarship awards apply up to and including Year 11. Award holders will be required to submit a new application at 16+.
